## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CLASS OF 2027

Graduation requirements for the Class of 2027

- English - 4 credits
- Math - 4 credits (Alg. I, Geom., Alg. II, \& 1 additional course)
- Bible - 2 credits (Apologetics \&1 additional course)
- World Language - 2 consecutive yrs. in the same language in grades 9-12.
- Fine or Performing Arts - 1 credit
- Social Studies - 3 credits (US History \& 2 additional courses)
- Science -3 credits (Biology, Chemistry \& 1 additional course)
- Physical Education \& Wellness - 1 credit
- Electives - 4 credits


## 24 total credits required for BCHS Diploma

Academic Diploma with Honors Endorsement :24 credits, plus a seven-semester weighted GPA of 3.8 in grades 9-12, that include six (6) credits in Honors and/or Advanced Placement courses from the BCS core classes of: English, Science, Math, Social Studies, World Languages, or Bible.
Academic Diploma with Fine Arts Endorsement: 24 credits in grades 9-12 that include five (5) credits in fine/performing arts and a sevensemester weighted GPA of 3.0 or higher.
Academic Diploma with Fine Arts and Honors Endorsement Requirements: 24 credits in grades 9-12 that include six (6) credits in Honors and/or Advanced Placement courses, five credits in fine/performing arts, and a seven-semester weighted GPA of 3.8 or higher.

The minimum twenty-four (24) credits required for graduation in ALL areas of endorsement for the high school diploma must be obtained in grades 9-12. High school courses that are completed in the eighth grade will be listed on the Briarcrest Christian High School transcript. These courses will NOT be included in the twenty-four (24) credits required for graduation and will NOT be included in the student's grade point average.
Students who took Latin I, French I, or Spanish I in grade 8 will have to take levels II and III in high school, if they continue with the same language.
