Why Dual Enrollment?

- Gain insight into the rigor of college level courses.
- Earn college credit toward your degree.
- Reduce the time it takes to earn a degree.





Admission Requirements

- 19 Composite ACT.
- 18 English sub-score (if taking English).
- 19 Math sub-score (if taking Math).
- 100 Index score (30 X your high school GPA on a 4.0 scale plus your ACT).

Example: $3.0 \times 30 = 90 + 19 = 109$.





Application Process

 Dual Enrollment Application (online).

 Apply for the lottery grant through TSAC (TSAC web site).





Transcripts - ACT Scores

- Your high school will send us your ACT scores and high school transcript.
- If you have earned dual enrollment credit in the past from another college you must have that college send us an official transcript.





Applying for the Lottery Grant

- Must apply for the grant each semester.
- The college you are taking the course from is where you direct your grant payment.
- Make sure you input the correct term.





Lottery Grant Application Deadlines:

Fall: by September 15

Spring: by February 1

Summer: by May 1





Effective fall 2015, a new Dual Enrollment course fee was established by the Tennessee Board of Regents (TBR). The fee is \$166 per semester hour:

- Three-hour class = \$498
- Four-hour class = \$664

Compared to \$1,201.50 (3) and \$1,602 (4) on campus.





Lottery Grant Funding

<u>Grant</u>

Student Fee

• First Course: \$500 Fee \$0

Second Course: \$500 Fee \$0

• Third Course: \$200 Fee \$298

Fourth Course: \$0 Fee \$498





Lottery Grant Funding

<u>Hope</u>

Student Fee (3/4)

• Fifth Course: \$300

Fee \$198/\$364

Sixth Course: \$300

Fee \$198/\$364

• Seventh Course: \$300

Fee \$198/\$364

• Eighth Course: \$300

Fee \$198/\$364
